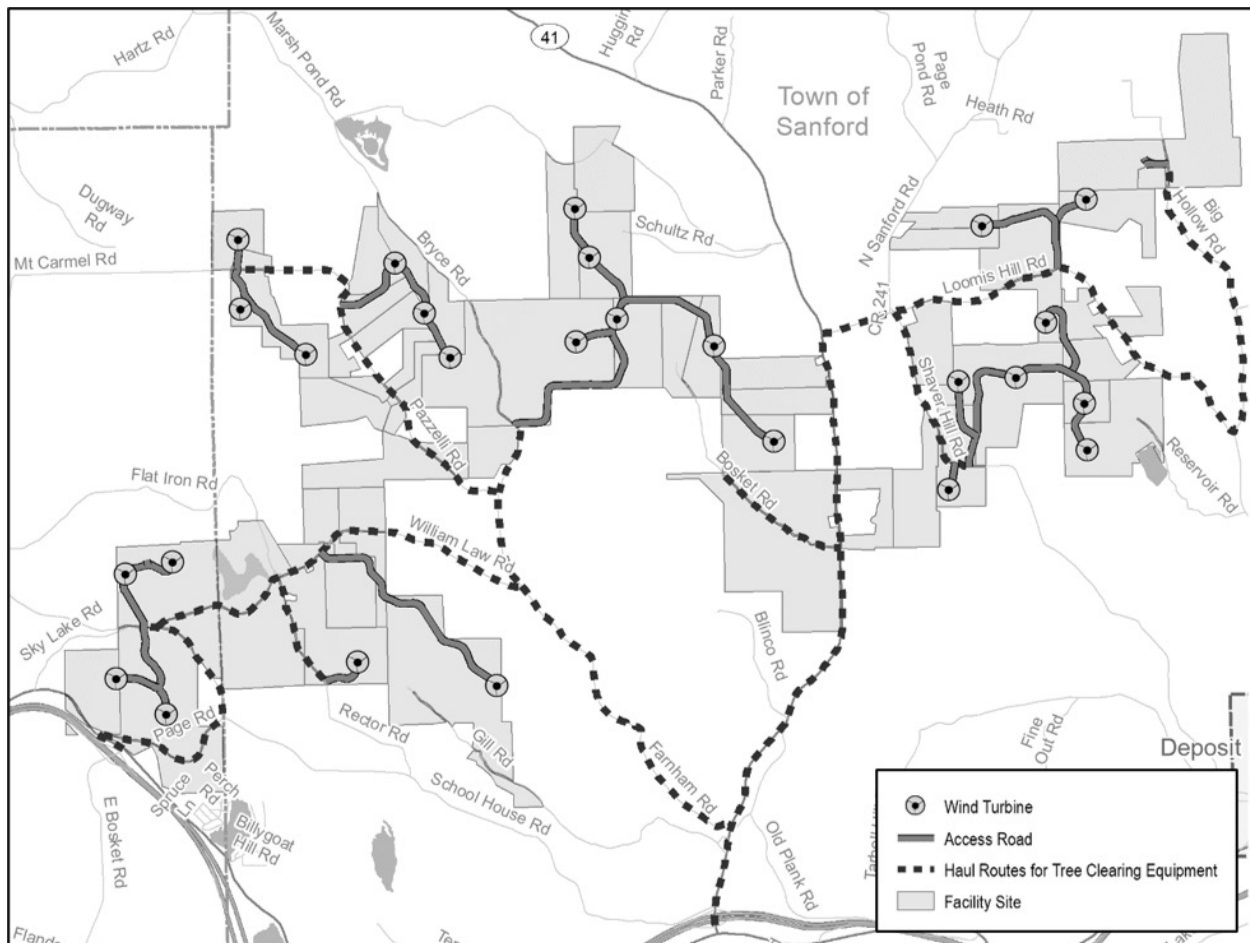


# Bluestone Wind Project's PRE-CONSTRUCTION NOTICE January 2021

This notice announces that, on or about February 8, 2021, Bluestone Wind LLC (Bluestone Wind or Certificate Holder) will begin tree clearing for the commencement of construction of the 124.2-megawatt wind-powered electric generation project located in the Towns of Sanford and Windsor, Broome County, NY (Facility).

Pursuant to the Article 10 process, this notice is being provided in accordance with Certificate Condition Nos. 20 & 21 in the *Order Granting Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, with Condition*, issued by the New York State Board on Electric Generation Siting and the Environment, on December 16, 2019. ## BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

Bluestone Wind will construct the Bluestone Wind Project, a wind energy generation facility and associated necessary infrastructure in the Towns of Sanford and Windsor, Broome County New York. When completed, the Project will be comprised of up to 26 wind turbines for a maximum generating capability of approximately 124.2 megawatts (MWs). The Project will also consist of approximately 13 miles of access roads, approximately 36 miles of 34.5 kilovolt (kV)

collection lines, a 34.5 kV collection substation, two proposed permanent meteorological (met) towers and an Operations and Maintenance (O&M) facility. All Facility components will be located within an area encompassing approximately 5,662 acres (the "Facility Site").

## THE CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

The tree-clearing phase of construction is scheduled to begin on or about February 8, 2021. Project tree clearing activities shall be limited to 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 8 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Sunday and on national holidays.
